**New Vision**<sup>TM</sup> is a medically supervised, hospital-based service for adults experiencing **impending or active withdrawal** from alcohol, prescription medications, and certain other drugs.

We offer inpatient medical stabilization & withdrawal management for appropriate adults. Only a licensed physician can determine those who qualify.

Patients are admitted to the hospital for a short stay (typically 3-5 days). They are treated by the hospitals' doctors & nurses. New Vision™ staff work with patients to create a discharge plan, connecting the patients with continuing care in the community.

Our withdrawal management service includes:

- Short-term inpatient stay (between 3-5 days)
- Confidential hospital environment under the supervision of a medical director & nursing staff
- Post-stabilization referral to a continued care recovery program
- Aftercare referral could include: long-term detox, inpatient or outpatient rehab
